CONDITIONS.

1. This licence is granted subject to all the provision of the Arms Act, 1959 and of the Arms Rules, 1962.
2. The articles shall not be conveyed by any route other than that specified in Col. 7 and bulk shall not be broken, nor shall the consignment be stopped, before the articles reach the place of destination.
3. An account of the contents of each package shall be legibly written thereon and where the article are conveyed by rail, each package shall be marked with the work " Arms" or "Ammunition", as the case may be, so as to be readily recognizable by the railway authorities.
4. The articles shall be delivered only to a person lawfully entitled to receive them.
