Press Note

As many as 962 seized and abandoned vehicles have gone up for 16th phase of public auction conducted by Hyderabad City Police at Goshamahal police grounds. On Monday under the supervision of Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad city.

During the auction, Sri M.Srinivas, IPS, Jt. CP CAR Hqrs, Hyd addressed the bidders (who are mostly from automobile field) and requested them to bid in a fair manner.

About 550 bidders from AP & TS states attended the event and a total of 959 vehicles were auctioned wherein 916 abandoned/unclaimed scrap vehicles (893 Two wheelers, 08 Three wheelers and 15 Four wheeler vehicles) of Hyderabad City were auctioned for Rs.56,07,000/- in scrap condition and the road worthy (43) vehicles (42) Two wheelers and (01) Four Wheeler were auctioned for Rs. 10,12,000/-

The total amount received in the auction out of the sale of 962 vehicles is Rs 66,19,000/- and (03) two wheeler vehicles were rejected for not reaching upset price fixed by RT authorities. This will be deposited in the Govt Treasury .

Despite notifying owners through press releases, most of them were reluctant to collect their vehicles. Some of the unclaimed vehicles condition have deteriorated to such an extent that they can only be sold to scrap dealers.

Chairman of auction committee Sri.M.Srinivas, IPS,Jt.CP, CAR Hqrs, Hyd, Sri N.Ashok Kumar, DCP-II, Traffic, Sri Maddipati Srinivas Rao, Addl DCP/Principal CPTC Petlaburz and other officers were present.
