On the occasion of Telangana Assembly Election (TSLA-2023) today Sri.Deepak Mishra IPS (Retd) Special Police Observer and Sri.Ajay V Naik IAS(Retd) Special General Observer visited the Command and Control Centre, TS-ICCC Building,Banjara Hills in the presence of Sri.Sandeep Shandilya IPS CP Hyderabad. To examine the functioning of CC Cameras (6000 CC Cameras) located at various polling stations (outside and inside) in Hyderabad.The conditions outside the polling centers was monitored through drone cameras. And the situation at critical polling centers in the city was inquired and monitored through cameras as well. The polling pattern at the polling stations was also examined.

APPREHENDED OF THREE ACCUSED PERSONS WITH INTENTION TO CONDUCT BOGUS VOTING ON TSLA-2023 ELECTIONS OF HABEEBNAGAR POLICE STATION.

The Habeebnagar Police with assistance of DCP, Task Force and her teams of South West zone have apprehended three accused persons who are with the intention of conducting bogus voting in the TSLA-2023 elections. Accused persons were found removing indelible ink marks from voters who had already cast their votes with the help of an unknown chemical. The three accused individuals, identified as Mohd Zakir, Mohd Shabuddin, and Ritesh Gupta, have been caught in possession of materials and registered a Cr. No. 336/2023, U/s 171(D) r/w 171(F), 419, 468, 471, 474 r/w 109 IPC under multiple sections of the Indian Penal Code and the R.P. Act. The case is under investigation for collection of more evidences.

The accused individuals had planned to carry out bogus voting on polling day and at Police Station No. 123 of Govt High School Telugu Medium Nampally had purchased materials to remove indelible ink marks from casted votes. They had identified a religious place, a shutter under the premises of a mosque, to conduct their activities. As per their plan they produced voters I.D. Cards of different from who were absent, died and shifted..

The police seized voter lists, duplicate voter ID cards, unused cotton, a chemical bottle, a mini slip printing machine, and paper rolls from the accused individuals. The accused individuals had collected the voter list and had identified unknown persons who had vacated their homes. They had used their voter ID numbers to print out information slips and had planned to conduct

bogus voting with the help of outside persons...

The three accused individuals were arrested by Sri Rambabu, SHO Habeebnagar PS with the support of Sri Srinivas, Inspector, Taskforce and his Sri Raja Venkat Reddy, ACP Asifnagar and with the team under the supervision and guidance of Smt Nitika Pant, IPS, DCP Taskforce and Sri B Balaswamy, IPS DCP South West Zone.

The police have taken strict action against the accused to ensure that the elections are conducted without any fraudulent activities.

Violation against Model Code of Conduct:-

This incident occurred on 30-11-2023 at 07:30 hours at Panchsheela Library near polling booth no: 194, falling within the jurisdiction of Chaderghat Police Station Hyderabad on the complaint of Sri. B. Bhargav PC 30589, PS Chaderghat, Hyderabad a case in Cr. No 457/2023 U/sec 171 (C) r/w 171 (E), 171 (F), 171 (H), 188 IPC & 130, 131 RP Act and took up the investigation.

Violation against Model Code of Conduct:-

Kareem PC 3909, PS Chaderghat, Hyderabad registered a case in Cr. No 458/2023 U/sec 171 (C) r/w 171 (E), 171 (H), 188 IPC and took up the investigation.
