

PRESS NOTE

3 DAYS TOT Program on CSA for Govt teachers has started from 29th January, 2024 at the Central Crime Station, Basheerbagh, by the Bharosa Society for Protection of Women and Children, working under the Hyderabad City Police.

Under the leadership of C.P Sri K. Sreenivasa Reddy, IPS, Hyderabad, along with the able guidance of Joint C.P Sri A. V. Ranganath and DCP WSW Smt. Dara Kavitha, a 3-day workshop is being conducted wherein each day 100 teachers are participating in the training to gain awareness and understanding of the POCSO Act, along with being aware of the ways to empower children to understand about abuse, safe and unsafe touch, how to and whom to report the abuse.

The workshop also aimed at sensitizing the teachers as responsible citizens to empathize with the child and take an active initiative in reporting such cases and helping children in getting justice by removing the stigma. The classes are being conducted by Psychological Counsellors of Bharosa, eminent personalities like Mr. David Raj of UNICEF and further, to make teachers aware of the cyber grooming and online CSA; a separate session on social media cyber-crimes is also being conducted by Ms. Seema Sikhri, HCSC.

The first day of the session was inaugurated by the CP, Hyderabad, Sri Kothakota Sreenivasa Reddy, IPS, along with Jt.CP, Crimes & SIT, Sri AV Ranganath, IPS.

The teachers have actively participated in the interactive sessions and all the doubts related to the POCSO Act have been clarified by the Bharosa team members. They have expressed their gratitude for conducting such an interactive session and are willing to conduct such same sessions in their respective schools.

During the TOT program, a new Tri-folder on "Recommended Action when Child Sexual Abuse is reported/ discovered at school" was released by the officers. Along with this, a new flyer on "How to Approach Bharosa" was also released by the CP, Hyderabad.

An exclusive WhatsApp group was created to communicate with the teachers on a regular basis and to share the related material. All the teachers pledged to build a safe and secure environment to the children by all means.
