NABBED (05) NOTORIOUS ROBBERS IN SENSATIONAL GUDIMALKAPUR CASE AND SEIZED NET CASH OF Rs. 43,80,000/- THREE I-PHONE 15 PRO MOBILE PHONES, APPLE I POD, AIR PISTOL, ACTIVE BIKE, TOTAL WORTH OF RS. 48,30,000/-

The sleuths of Commissioner's Task Force, South West Team along with Gudimalkpur Police have apprehended (05) Notorious offenders in Gudimalkapur robbery case. Who were robbed the huge amount of cash from the complainant by showing the Air pistol putting in fear of injury with criminal conspiracy near Pan.Com, Pan Shop, Pillar No. 28, Mehdipatnam, Hyderabad.

PARTICULARS OF ACCUSED PERSONS:

- 1) Sardar Harpreet Singh Rishi, 8/o: Late Sardar Amarjeet Singh, Age: 22 Yrs, Occ: Unemployed, R/o: Sikh Chowni, Kishan Bagh, Attapur, Hyderabad.
- 2) Sardar Manpreet Singh Manpreet, S/o: Late Sardar Dayal Singh, Age: 25 Yrs, Occ: Unemployed, R/o. Opp: Kalgidhar School, Nanded Dist, Maharashtra State.
- 3) Sardar Gurjeet Singh Raj, S/o: Late Sardar Amarjeet Singh, Age: 21 Yrs, Oce: Unemployed, R/o.Sikh Chowni, Kishan Bagh, Attapur, Hyderabad.
- 4) Mohammed Ghufraan Ilahi @ Abbu S/o Mohd Ghouse, Age: 20 yrs, occ: Student, R/o. RTC X road, Hyderabad.

Brief about Case:

The accused Sardar Harpreet Singh @ Rishi, Sardar Gurjeet Singh @ Raj are brothers. Harpreet & Manpreet Singh are friend whereas Mohammed Ghufraan Ilahi @ Abbu, and Shravan Deshetty are college classmates of Gurjeet. Harpreet Singh's parents expired, and he lives with his brother, relying on rental income from their flats. Harpreet met Manpreet at Nanded Gurudwara and became friends. Harpreet sought easy money due to financial struggles and shared this with his younger brother and

brother friends. Manpreet also sought easy money to settle family debts. Shraavan, a former employee of Tibarumal Jewellers, Banjara hills branch, Hyderabad and shared information about the manager (Complainant) collecting daily cash from his jewellery shop and taking it home and next day same amount of cash deposit in Bank. Harpreet stolen air pistol from his cousin, Gurpreet Singh's residence. Further Manpreet arrived in Hyderabad, and they planned the robbery. As per their plan, on 30-08-2024, in the evening hours, Harpreet Singh along with Manpreet were wearing helmets and jackets so that they could not get identified and after reaching the spot and instructed Abbu to stay far from the Jewellery showroom and keep an eye and intimate them about the movements of Complainant. Later Complainant along with his colleague both started on one Honda Activa vehicle towards Complainant's house situated at Kishan Bagh. When they reached near Pillar No. 28 and stopped their vehicle near Pan.Com, Pan Shop, Mehdiapatnam road, Hyderabad to have pan wherein the Complainant was standing near the vehicle along with the cash bag and his colleague went to bring Pans for them. Meanwhile Harpreet and Manpreet approached Complainant, who was standing with a cash bag, and threatened him with the air pistol. They grabbed the bag and fled on a Honda Activa. Later, accused persons purchased the three iPhone 15 pro mobile phone, ear pods from stolen amount and kept with them for use. On the tip off, The Commissioner's Task Force, South West Zone team along with Gudimalkapur Police had apprehended and recovered Net Cash Of Rs. 43,80,000, mobile phones and air pistol, Helmets and jackets, Total worth of Rs.48,30,000/- from their possession. Matters pertaining in Cr. No. 418/2024, U/Sec. 309(4) BNS of PS Gudimalkapur against the accused persons.
